The **jewel in the crown** of the Kingdom's Vision 2030 **diversification** program is undoubtedly Neom which will cost an estimated 500 billion dollars to construct alone. Neom claims to be a **blueprint** for tomorrow in which humanity progresses without **compromising** the health of the planet.



The Crown Prince of Saudi Arabia Mohammed bin Salman announced the launch of the nation's first futuristic and fully animated business zone Neom in 2017. Saudi Arabia's Vision 2030 outlines 1.8 trillion dollars in investment in infrastructure, education, housing and health care over 10 years in a bid to develop the private sector and create new jobs. The goals of Vision 2030 are to enhance the effectiveness of Saudi Arabia and improve the guality of life for its citizens, increase the nation's income, and diversify the economy by creating new industries. The new city Neom is named from a combination of the Greek word for new and the Arabic term for future covering a total area of over 26, 500 square kilometers larger than Kuwait or in fact Israel. Neom will exist entirely outside the confines of the current Saudi judicial system and governed by an autonomous legal system that investors will draft up. This high-tech business hub is to be located in the Tabuk province in the northwestern part of Saudi Arabia along the Red Sea Coast.


The region has been selected because of its relatively mild climate. The project is expected to generate 380 thousand jobs and contribute 48 billion US dollars to the Kingdom's GDP by 2030. The goal of the project is to demonstrate that the Kingdom has the capacity to develop large-scale urban centers that can serve as economic hubs even as it continues to produce a majority of its energy needs through oil and gas. The future city is being designed to maximize the use of renewable energy and employ cutting edge technology. Initial plans for the city include drone taxis, a Jurassic Park style amusement park, and a giant artificial moon that lights at night. The reports state that the futuristic city-state is being built using artificial intelligence and clean energy sources. The planners of the city have said that they would provide bullet trains and a hyperloop for transportation but residents would be encouraged to use bicycles.

Neom's official website, which seems like something out of a Sci-Fi novel, claims that the first phase of the mega territory will be completed by 2025. Neom will consist of three major regions namely Octagon, Trojena, and the Line. (*stops at 3:11*)
