

Transportation secretary Jaime Bautista orders the office of Transportation Security to **file charges** and **impose** the maximum penalty on the security screener accused of stealing and swallowing 300 US dollars from a passenger.

In the statement, the Department of Transportation says Bautista has already directed Undersecretary for Legal Affairs Attorney Reinier Yebra to assist in filing complaints against those involved in the **theft** incident.

On September 8th, a checkpoint supervisor reported that a passenger lost 300 US dollars at the Ninoy International Airport Terminal 1. The OTR says CCTV **footage** shows a female security officer stealing and apparently swallowing the missing cash.

The agency adds that Bautista has authorized imposing the maximum penalty to those found guilty to demonstrate their demonstration to rid NAIA and attached agencies of **scalawags**.

Meanwhile the OTS has already placed a personal under **preventive suspension**. **Pending** investigation also recommending for **legally and administratively** charged the security screener.

## Four Screening Officers Under Probe: NAIA \$300 Theft Case


The office for Transportation Security is currently investigating four screening officers allegedly involved in a theft incident at Ninoy Aquino International Airport where one **apparently** swallowed 300 US dollars in cash. On September 8th, a checkpoint supervisor reported that a passenger lost 300 US dollars at the Ninoy International Airport Terminal 1. CCTV footage shows a female security officer stealing and apparently swallowing the missing cash.

In a television interview, OTS Administrator Ma.O Aplasca says three more officers have been identified as **accomplices**. According to Aplasca, the main **culprit** behind the **thieving** incident continues to **deny** that she stole or swallowed the cash but Aplasca says he believes they have enough evidence to charge the **culprit** and her accomplices. The OTS Chief says Transportation Secretary Jaime Bautista has already ordered the agency to file both administrative and criminal cases against the involved personnel.
