An Incan girl believed to have been **sacrificed** 500 years ago was **brought back to life** in image. Archeologists say they found the **mummified** body of the girl they call "Juanita" near a volcano in the Andes Mountains of Peru in 1995. They have been trying to **piece together** what they can about her story ever since.

"It's a difficult feeling to express because when I saw it was over 20 thousand feet. Her face had been dried out because the cloth covering it had been **torn apart** as she and a burial fell down inside a **crater**."

Experts 3D technology to **reconstruct** her face. They say they believe she was 14 or 15 years old when she died. When she died, a **fissure** on her skull leads them to believe that she died after being hit on the head, possibly as an **offering to the gods** to stop natural disasters such as floods, **droughts**, or volcanic eruptions.

"28 years later, it's done in a **magnificent way**. She has this **pensive** look that is made possible only by someone with great ability with this kind of work. Seeing what Juanita may have looked makes her story all the more real.
